## **ANZRS AI Award for Best Conference Paper**

The Australia and New Zealand Regional Science Association (ANZRS AI) will host its 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference on the RMIT University City Campus in Melbourne, 6-7 December 2021. The theme this year is “**Risk! The Challenge of Managing Risks to Regional Futures**”.

At the conference, ANZRS AI will present an Award for the Best Conference Paper, sponsored by the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications. There is a small cash grant for the winner (\$500). To be eligible for this Award, the following conditions must be met:

- An abstract for the paper is submitted on-line by 27 September 2021.
- A copy of the full paper is sent to Professor Paul Dalziel by email at [paul.dalziel@lincoln.ac.nz](mailto:paul.dalziel@lincoln.ac.nz) by 1 November 2021.
- The paper is presented at the conference by one of the authors.

The ANZRS AI Award for Best Conference Paper 2019 was awarded to Robert J Stimson and Alistair Robson for their paper “Endogenous Employment Performance of Non-Metropolitan Regions Across Australia 2006-16”.
